
Johnson has stood first in his college and he is waiting to get his Gold Medal from the college.

Vocational training

16 unprivileged young girls are trained in the tailoring and embroidery course in remote and neglected places around Nilgiris.

6 children have been rescued from child labour and now they are happily going to school.

8 deserving boys were given vocational training.



18 of our children have successfully finished their Junior College, 15 children have scored distinction. It was a proud moment to see our children getting the crown in their studies. 12 of our children are now in the final year Junior college.



Leena Grace stood school first in her school.

25 of our children have successfully finished their high school with good marks and joining Junior College. All of them have completed with distinction in the final year high school examination.

18 of our children are going to write their final year high school examination in the coming academic year.





To encourage the children, we sponsor rolling cups and shields in four different Schools for the "Best Out-going Students"

45 deserving children were given Scholarships to continue their studies.

6 children have been rescued from child labour and now they are happily going to school.

Most of our Children have got a special award for their 100% attendance during this academic year.

Nandhin, Subashini, Sneha, vinisha, vidhyawathi won the district level prizes. Jefrin, Arthi won the best cadet award in the school NCC.

Value-added education and awareness programme have been hosted in 6 different schools by Isaac.

Children and youth counselling are being effectively done and many children are availing these facilities





This year summer camp for the children was organized. 80 children have participated.

One broken family has been reunited after the counselling given by Isaac and Margaret

We have visited more than 15 villages and worked among the neglected people.


Various training Programme like fish farming, Organic Farming, Goat Farming was conducted in Bethany gardens for the local youth and farmers
